

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
January 20, 2010
ANTUN'S

1750 Hours

Meeting called to order and Pledge of Allegiance by Patrick Ferraiuolo, President. The reading of November meeting minutes waived by Captain Perrone and seconded by Captain Phillips. All Executive Board Members present except for Otis Blount who was excused.

President Patrick Ferraiuolo – *President Ferraiuolo welcomed the membership and offered a moment of silence for Captain Pascal Cadet's (BKCTS) sister who passed away in Haiti. He acknowledged the devastation caused by the earthquake in Haiti and informed the membership that we have many members of service that are directly affected by this tragic event. The C.C.A. will give a donation in addition to collecting donations from our members. All monies will be turned over to the Mayors Relief Fund. President Ferraiuolo then introduced Larry W. Davis, Sr., Chief of Department and William Clemons, Executive Assistant, Chief of Department.*

Larry W. Davis, Sr., Chief of Department – *He introduced himself to the membership and thanked President Ferraiuolo and the Board for inviting him to our meeting. He gave a brief history of his tenure with the Department of Correction and proceeded to address the membership. Chief Davis' mission statement was one of mutual respect. "Everyone should be kind to each other, come to work with a positive attitude, don't mistreat each other and treat others the way you want to be treated." The Chief also focused on the importance of training our "young" staff. He informed the membership that as first line supervisors they have a very important role. Captains must ensure that the Officers are doing their jobs, be willing to teach the Officers and each other, use progressive discipline when necessary and always be prepared to lead. Lastly, Chief Davis stressed the importance of integrity as individuals and in the scope of the performance of our duties. He then opened the floor for discussion but none was offered.*

President Patrick Ferraiuolo – *He acknowledged the following providers present at the meeting: Debbie Internicola from Amalgamated: Milan Rada and Richard Brandenstein from Fusco, Brandenstein & Rada. President Ferraiuolo also acknowledged past CCA Presidents, Peter Meringolo and Ronald Whitfield. He informed the membership that the March Delegates and General Membership meeting has been changed from March 17th to March 24th. He informed the membership that Healthplex has informed us that they will be eliminating our social security numbers as identification numbers on their benefits cards. Captains are being made the subject of disciplinary action as it pertains to this matter. President Ferraiuolo stated that he was overwhelmed and turned the meeting over to William Inman, 1st Vice President.

William Inman, 1st Vice President – *He spoke about (2) Oath cases both occurring at A.M.K.C. He informed the membership about the issues of each case and that we hope for a positive outcome. We are currently waiting for a decision from Commissioner Schriro.*

President Patrick Ferraiuolo – *President Ferraiuolo stated that he and 1st Vice President Inman attended the State of the State Address in Albany to forge a relationship with City Council members, State Senators and members of the Assembly that will assist us in achieving new legislation for our members benefit. He stated that Captain Graham's next court date is March 2, 2010. Please make an effort to attend, he needs your support.*

Open Discussion – *Captain Perrone, OBCC asked if the EHO post can be cut. President Ferraiuolo stated that we don't want any posts to be cut. Motion to close by retired Captain Krifchin and seconded by Captain Perrone.*
