

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
November 18, 2009

Meeting called to order and Pledge of Allegiance by William Inman, 1st Vice President. The reading of the October meeting minutes waived by Captain Krifchin, seconded by Captain Perrone. All Executive Board Members present except for Guy Brown who is on vacation. Also in attendance were Special Counsel Harry Greenberg.

President Patrick Ferraiuolo – *President Ferraiuolo welcomed the membership and offered a moment of silence for Captain Fredericks' (RNDC) sister who passed away. He acknowledged the following providers present at the meeting: Mike DeStefano and Ray Millian, AFLAC; Debbie Inernicola, Amalgamated and Milan Rada of Fusco, Brandensten & Rada. He also acknowledged past CCA Presidents Peter Meringolo and Ronald Whitfield.*

Mike DeStefano (AFLAC) – *He distributed an application package and explained a new benefit, Accident Plan that AFLAC is offering to our members.*

President Patrick Ferraiuolo – *He informed the membership of Captain Victor Stanfield's (OBCC) passing on November 1, 2009 and the untimely passing of Captain T. Bowser's (RMSC) brother. He offered a moment of silence for both of them.*

Joe Ferramosca – *He informed the membership that we have increased our Health and Welfare benefits. All members may receive a \$100.00 reimbursement yearly which they can apply towards medical, hospital, optical or prescription co-payments or deductibles effective January 1, 2010. Retirees will receive a \$75.00 increase for their prescription rider benefits retroactive to September 1, 2009.*

Harry Greenberg – *He informed the membership that we won our EHO/Programs grievance at Arbitration and effective immediately, EHO posts can no longer be shift reduced along with the Programs post in NIC, which covers the Clinic.*

President Patrick Ferraiuolo – *He explained Special Duty Pay. He stated that he does not like the current selection process of which our members receive this monetary award and he will propose a change to the criteria when he meets with Commissioner Schriro. He stated that our annual Christmas Party is December 16, 2009. He informed the membership that Captain Graham's next court date is January 19, 2010 and urged them to support him.*
